Getting around	There are 3 lines connecting the centre with the suburbs (A, B, C), user friendly. Operates from 5 AM to midnight (except for New Year's Eve and Christmas when the hours are prolonged).	Day trams are marked by numbers 1-36, run from app. 6 AM till after midnight. Night trams are marked 50-59 and run all night (intervals of max. 20 minutes). The major connecting point for night trams is the stop Lazarska, close to the Wenceslas Square.	Most useful when traveling to distant parts of the city, night buses go from the Central Station (Hlavní nádraží), I.P.Pavlova and few others.
